Re: Registration Fee Credit

Following a recent agency audit, the interpretation of our statute has changed, and the Board is now operating on an updated interpretation. The Board decided to change the fee back to \$225 pending changes in the statute and offer credits to those who paid the \$300 registration fees.

The fee was changed back to \$225 in the on-line renewal system September 13th. The Board voted today to give licensees the option of receiving a \$75 refund for each \$300 paid; or be credited four months on each registration where \$300 was paid.

For example, if you paid \$300 for a registration good through January 1, 2019, that registration expiration would be extended to May 1, 2019, and you will receive a new certificate with that date.

If you renewed twice since January 1, 2017 at \$300 each, you would be credited eight months on your expiration date. So, the same registration due to expire January 1, 2019 would now expire September 1, 2019.

The Board is requesting a response within 30 days, either by email or letter, on the option you choose to take. If no response is received prior to October 26th, you will automatically be credited for each registration and a new certificate will be issued.
